

Day 1

Welcome to Jordan!

Private transfer: about 35km and 40min


Welcome to the beautiful country of Jordan! You can expect very special moments and impressions that you will remember for a lifetime. Already the first day starts with an exciting action: We meet women who teach us to cook Jordanian dishes. What exactly we want to cook, we can decide on the spot. But one thing is for sure: You can already look forward to cooking new, delicious dishes at home after your adventure. (-/-/D)

Day 2

Experience the city of Amman and its special charm.

Private transfer: about 130km and 2.5 h

After breakfast, we will take a journey through time to the largest vineyard of the Mafrag Plateau, where a volcano once covered a fertile forest and created a magical basalt terroir. On this half day tour we will get to know this unique 100 hectare vineyard in the basalt desert of Jordan. In the evening we will go for a walk in the oldest streets of Jordan, known as the Heritage Town of Amman. Here the old houses have been converted into restaurants and cafes. After this street food experience, we end our walk in a café where we can enjoy tea or coffee and mingle with Jordanians to experience the real life of the locals. At the end of the day, we will discover Amman's Old City in the city center. (B/-/D)



Day 3

Marvel at Petra by night in candlelight

Private transfer1: about 70km and 1,5 h

Hike: about 1 h

Private transfer2: about 290km and 4 h

In the morning, we prepare to visit the Biscuit House, currently run by women from the community as part of a new model of community engagement that transforms women from traditional employees to true community entrepreneurs. At noon, we will experience a local gallyeh or sajiyeh before embarking on a short circular hike. This hike offers a magnificent view of the reserve. Not far from the campsite is an old stone wine press. Early in the morning we may be lucky enough to see deer before returning to the visitor center. In the evening, it is an amazing experience to see Petra at night by the light of 1,800 candles - it is truly breathtaking! We walk along a candlelit path through the Siq to the Khazneh and enjoy the haunting music of the Bedouins in the Treasury. (B/L/-)



Day 4

The only Nabataean city

We visit the Nabataean city of Petra, one of the 7 Wonders of the World and UNESCO World Heritage Site. We enter the city through a 1 km long narrow gorge flanked on both sides by 80 m high cliffs! Here we can admire the dazzling colors and formations of the rocks. The site is immense and includes hundreds of artfully carved rock tombs, a treasury, Roman style theaters, temples, sacrificial altars and colonnaded streets. (B/-/-)

Day 5

A jeep ride through the desert

Private transfer: about 110km and 2 h

Jeep ride: about 4 h

After fortifying ourselves at the hotel, we explore Wadi Rum on a 4-hour jeep ride through the Jordanian desert! Wadi Rum was described by T.E. Lawrence as "vast, echoing and godlike" and by the locals as the "Valley of the Moon". During the jeep tour we will discover many things: The Nabatean Temple, Lawrence Spring, Khazali Dune, Khazali Canyon, Little Rock Bridge, Um Frouth Rock Bridge and Lawrence's home. Here we can enjoy the Bedouin hospitality at dinner and taste the Bedouin feast Zarb. Zarb (as the locals call it) or, if you will, Bedouin barbecue is an experience in itself, where Bedouins cook lamb, chicken and vegetables with herbs in a large underground pit with hot coals under the desert sand. When the meat is tender and has a hint of smoky flavor, the large pot is brought out and we can enjoy one of Jordan's greatest edible treasures under the starry skies of Wadi Rum. (B/L/D)

Day 6

Breathtaking waterfalls

Private transfer: about 270km and 3.5 h

After breakfast, the trail begins at the visitor center near the Mujib Bridge, where we take the cantilevered footbridge over the dam and follow the river's course between towering sandstone cliffs to the base of a large waterfall. Depending on the seasonal rainfall, the gorge may contain pools deep enough for swimming. This is an ideal trail to walk slowly and enjoy the cool water and shade, especially in the summer heat. In the evening, we enjoy some free time and can explore the area on our own. (B/-/-)

Day 7

Swimming in the Dead Sea

Private transfer: about 70km and 1,5 h

Enjoy a free day at the Dead Sea today. No body of water in the world is deeper than this and the salt content of the water gives the lake a special charm. However, care should be taken to wear rubber shoes while bathing so as not to cut yourself on the many small salt stones at the bottom of the water. Also, care should be taken not to swallow Dead Sea water and not to bring the water into contact with the eyes, as the salt content is very high. After about 15 minutes you should leave the water, otherwise the salt content will extract too much liquid from your body. (B/-/D)

Day 8

Goodbye Jordan

Private transfer: about 65km and 1 h

And already the adventure comes to an end. The last days were a wonderful experience, with great nature, many new impressions and new friends. Enjoy a last breakfast with your new friends and then slowly but surely head to the airport to embark on your next adventure. Maybe we will see each other again soon? We're looking forward to seeing you. (B/-/-)
